Officials' Biographies

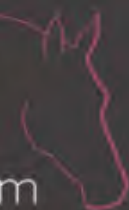
Susan Mandas is a 'USEF "S" Dressage Judge and "R" DSHB judge, who resides in Dayton, OH. She has trained and competed in dressage for over 45 years. Sue rode in her first national finals in 1968 where she was reserve champion AHSA Junior Medal Finalist and she went on to become Senior Medalist in 1969. With the mare "Phaion", she won her USDF Bronze and Silver Medals and was long listed with the USET in 1984. "Whiz Kid" was another successful mount, a Hanoverian bred in the US and started by Ms. Mandas. In 1998 "Whiz" and Sue were placed on the USET Developing Rider List. Sue continues to ride and train horses, as well as judge and she serves on the USDF Executive Board and USDF Sport Horse Committee.

Anne Appleby is a USEF "S" dressage judge, from Olympia Washington. She trained and competed a Norwegian Fjord at the Grand Prix level and is the owner of owner at Kamilche Sea Farms, which has been farming mussels in Puget Sound since 1981.

Anne Moss lives with her Husband John in Coatesville, PA. with two dogs, three horses, and a nice flock of hens. She enjoys many horse sports, and especially riding and teaching side saddle. Her background is mainly in Pony Club (graduate "A" from Huntingdon Valley Hunt Pony Club), western equitation and gymkhana, pleasure driving, eventing through Intermediate 3-Day, dressage to Grand Prix level, side saddle (earning her USDF Bronze and Silver Medals riding side saddle), and foxhunting. She is a certified instructor for ARIA for dressage and side saddle, Side Saddle Association (UK), and the International Side Saddle Association. She has been practice manager for her husband John's Brandywine Valley Veterinary Hospital for the many years. When not riding or showing her favorite horses Rocky and Grace, she enjoys pottery, horticulture, historical reenacting (Civil War, Wild West and Rendezvous) with and without horses, trail riding, open hearth cooking and baking, traveling and volunteering. She loves to organize USDF "L" Programs, USEF Judges Programs, and USDF Sport Horse Seminars. She serves/has served on non-profit boards and committees including: Dressage at Devon, DVCTA Past President, USPC (National Examiner and N.E. Committee), USDF Historical Recognition Committee, and USDF Freestyle Committee, International Side Saddle Organization, Cochran Hunt Member-at-Large.

Frances Cross began her career in Massachusetts, where she graduated from U MA – Amherst. She owned and operated King Oak Farm, a successful boarding, training, and sales facility. Since then, she has relocated to Ocala, FL, were she formerly operated a small boarding and sales facility. She now spends her time officiating in dressage and eventing. Fran is a Level 2 FEI Steward in Eventing and Level 3 Steward in Dressage as well as a Dressage TD. She has officiated at the Land Rover Kentucky Three-Day Event, Maryland 5* Event, World Equestrian Games in both Kentucky and Tryon, Pan Am Games in Peru and Toronto, and various other competitions both domestically and internationally. When not officiating, she enjoys "playing in the dirt" to make flowers grow and spending time with her husband, Tom and their Jack Russell.

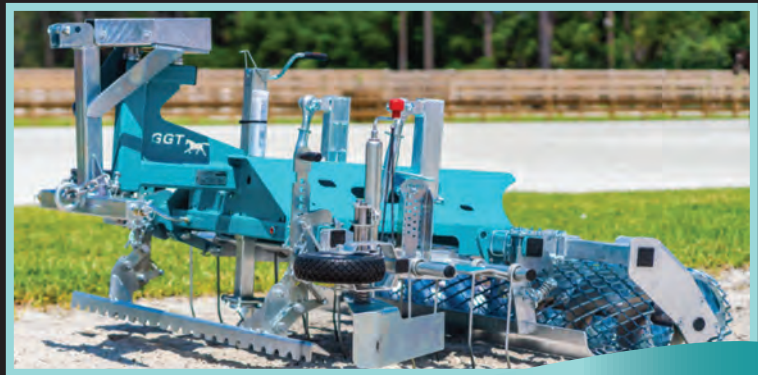

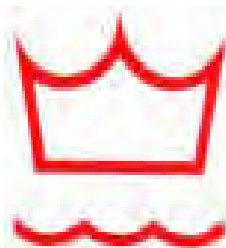

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of individual members and over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

- Separate awards for Open, AAs and/or Jr/YRs in any Dressage Open class with four or more in any division. All divisions (if specifically offered) pinned separately. Exception: GAIG/USDF Qual & CBLM not pinned separately.
- Dressage High Score awards at Training-Fourth Levels, FEI Levels combined in each competition (ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Opportunity & YH tests).
- DSHB Championship classes receive Champion and Reserve Championship ribbons.
- DSHB Grand Champion: Will receive special award and neck sash.
- USDFBC: Champion & Reserve Champion in classes B15, B16, B17, B19, B20 & B21 in each show will receive USDF neck sashes & qualify for ProElite/USDF Breeders Championship East Coast Series Final at Dressage at Devon.
- High Score AA: To highest scoring AA in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro & YH tests on Saturday only.
- High Score Jr/YR: To highest scoring Jr/YR in any class ex. Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro & YH tests on Saturday only.
- Pony TOC (CI.184) Animals age 3 or over must have current USEF Pony Measurement Certificate. If under age three must present evidence that sire and/or dam (either or both) are registered with a pony breed or have a valid USEF Pony Measurement Certificate.
- NCDCTA Pony and Small Horse Champions Series: High Score Open, Adult Amateur, and Jr/Yr for Pony and Small Horse Under Saddle and Young and Mature Pony In Hand. Pony performance must be entered in Pony TOC class. Small horse defined as less than 16hh with shoes. Measurement documentation required, measurements for Ponies Only available at show. See ncdcta.org for full series details and measurement forms, sign up at awards table by 8am Saturday 8/31. Series championships to be held at Labor of Love II (Pony In Hand) and Autumn Leaves Dressage (Performance).
- Super Senior Award: High Score for horses aged 20 and over, excluding DSE, MFS, Materiale and YH tests. Sign up at awards table. Sponsored by Ali Perkins Dressage.
- National Dressage Pony Cup High Point Awards: High Point and Reserve awards to the highest scoring pony in any class except Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro & YH tests. Only ponies with valid USEF measurement certificates submitted to the show secretary will be eligible.
- TIP Awards: The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) is offering a high score ribbon for Thoroughbreds. Eligible horses must provide T.I.P. Numbers to the event secretary with entry. For more information, visit www.tjctip.com. All classes count except Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle, Intro & YH tests.
- American Hanoverian Society: Special ribbon to the highest placing eligible Hanoverian in individual in-hand classes (IBC excluded). In order to be eligible, horse must be AHS registered and owner must be a current AHS member. AHS eligibility verified week prior to show. (One award for both shows combined.)
- Dressage High Score Hanoverian: Sponsored by AHS. No AHS membership required. All levels eligible, excluding Intro, Equitation, Materiale, Freestyle & YH tests. Winner receives neck sash. One Dressage award for both shows combined, to be presented on Sunday.
- North American Danish Warmblood Association (One award/both shows combined). Sponsored by NADWA: Dressage & DSHB awards to highest scoring eligible DWB. Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests. DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand and IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- American Trakehner Association (One award/both shows combined). Sponsored by ATA: Dressage & DSHB awards to highest scoring eligible ATA registered horse. Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests. DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand and IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- ISR/Oldenburg NA (One award/both shows combined). Dressage award to highest scoring eligible ISR/Oldenburg reg horse. Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests.
- KWPN-NA – (One award/both shows combined). Dressage award to highest scoring KWPN reg horse. Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests.
- International Andalusian & Lusitano Horse Assn: (One award/both shows combined). Dressage award to highest scoring IALHA reg horse. Excl. Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests.
- WESTFALEN: (One award/both shows combined). Dressage & DSHB awards to highest scoring eligible Westfalen Verband NA reg horse. Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests. DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand and IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- RPSI: (One award/both shows). Dressage & DSHB awards to highest scoring eligible RPSI reg horse. Excl Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests. DSHB incl. indiv. in-hand & IBC, but not handler, group, US or Materiale classes.
- American Saddlebred High Point Award: (One award/both shows combined). Sponsored by ASR; Neck ribbon to the highest scoring Saddlebred or Half Saddlebred enrolled in the American Saddlebred Year End Awards Program. Owner must be an ASHA member. Must provide proof of membership and awards eligibility sticker on registration papers.
- Ezium Stock Horse: (One award/both shows combined). Dressage award to highest scoring registered Stock Horse (Quarter Horses, Appaloosas, and Paints). Excludes Equitation, Materiale, FS, Intro & YH tests.

USDF Membership Benefits: USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.
